The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. In the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

STUD DOG CLASS WILL BE FOR STUD DOGS AND TWO OF THEIR GET. STUD DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN THE STUD DOG CLASS AND MUST BE SHOWN IN THE RING WITH THEIR GET. OWNERS OF THE STUD DOG NEED NOT NECESSARILY BE THE OWNER OF THE GET. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IN THE STUD DOG CLASS WILL BE BASED ON THE MERITS OF MORE THAN ONE DOG. THE ENTRY JUDGED FIRST IN THIS CLASS WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE FOR BEST OF BREED BY VIRTUE OF HAVING WON THIS CLASS. GET MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS. BROOD BITCH CLASS ---SAME AS ABOVE EXCEPT SUBSTITUTE BROOD BITCH FOR STUD DOG, PRODUCE FOR GET.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: BOYS AND GIRLS WHO ARE AT LEAST 12 YEARS AND UNDER 15 YEARS OLD ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND WHO, AT THE TIME ENTRIES CLOSE, HAVE NOT WON THREE FIRST PLACES, WITH COMPETITION PRESENT, IN A NOVICE CLASS AT A LICENCED OR MEMBER SHOW.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: BOYS AND GIRLS WHO ARE AT LEAST 10 YEARS AND UNDER 12 YEARS OLD ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND WHO, AT THE TIME ENTRIES CLOSE, HAVE NOT WON THREE FIRST PLACES, WITH COMPETITION PRESENT, IN A NOVICE CLASS AT A LICENCED OR MEMBER SHOW.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: BOYS AND GIRLS WHO ARE AT LEAST 12 YEARS AND UNDER 15 YEARS OLD ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND WHO, AT THE TIME ENTRIES CLOSE, HAVE NOT WON THREE FIRST PLACES, WITH COMPETITION PRESENT, IN A NOVICE CLASS AT A LICENCED OR MEMBER SHOW.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: BOYS AND GIRLS WHO ARE AT LEAST 15 YEARS AND UNDER 18 YEARS OLD ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW AND WHO, AT THE TIME ENTRIES CLOSE, HAVE NOT WON THREE FIRST PLACES, WITH COMPETITION PRESENT, IN A NOVICE CLASS AT A LICENCED OR MEMBER SHOW.

COMPETITION MUST EXIST FOR BEST JUNIOR HANDLER.

JUNIORS WHO SUBSTITUTE FOR THE ORIGINAL DOG THEY HAVE ENTERED IN THE JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES WITH DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED IN ONE OF THE OFFERED CLASSES AT THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY ENTRY FEE WITH THEIR SUBSTITUTION.

PARADE OF VETERANS

THIS IS A NON-COMPETITIVE CLASS FOR DOGS AND BITCHES 7 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER (NEED NOT BE CHAMPIONS). PLEASE SUBMIT A BRIEF RESUME ON THE ENTRY FORM. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE. EACH ENTRANT WILL RECEIVE A SASH WITH THE DOG'S FULL AKC REGISTERED NAME ENGRAVED IN GOLD LETTERING.

MOVE UPS

EFFECTIVE FOR ALL SHOWS HELD AFTER JULY 1, 1990, DOGS WHICH ACCORDING TO THEIR OWNER'S RECORDS HAVE COMPLETED THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A CHAMPIONSHIP AFTER THE CLOSING OF ENTRIES FOR THE SHOW, BUT WHOSE CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE UNCONFIRMED, MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE OF THE REGULAR CLASSES TO THE BEST OF BREED COMPETITION, PROVIDED THIS TRANSFER IS MADE BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OR SHOW SECRETARY AT LEAST ONE HALF HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF REGULAR CONFORMATION JUDGING AT THE SHOW.

SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

- In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.
