Event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all fees for the A.K.C. & payment of all fees to the A.K.C. as stipulated in *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2*

**ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED:**

- In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee
- For duplicate entries
- If the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or show secretary

**No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Entries not on OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS (or photocopies of same which do not include the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side) are not acceptable.**

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by fax, telegram or e-mail **JDC\_ShowSecretary@msn.com** prior to close of entries. Those received verbally by telephone are not acceptable.

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with Int'l Money Orders guaranteed in US Funds  
 Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no person shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

There is no space provided for unentered dogs. Puppies and dogs not entered in this show are not permitted on the show grounds.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed. All awards will be made in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award.

for dogs & bitches seven (7) years or older

**NOTE:** Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** in the Veteran Dog Class(s) and spayed females **may be entered** in the Veteran Bitch Class(s) at independent specialties only.

**NOTE:** 1<sup>st</sup> Place winners of Veteran Dog / Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed **IF** undefeated in any other class at this show.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:**

**NOTE:** Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a *Championship* after Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the *Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition*, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of judging at this show. (Chapter 11, Section 6, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*)

**AWARD(S) OF MERIT:**

At the discretion of the judge **UP TO 3 AWARDS OF MERIT** may be awarded after the selection of Best of Breed, Best of Winners & Best of Opposite Sex. These awards are for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

**BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES**

For 1<sup>st</sup> Place Winners (Dogs & Bitches) in the Regular Puppy Classes (6-9 Mos & 9-12 Mos)

**BEST ENTRY IN BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES**

**BEST ENTRY IN VETERAN CLASSES**

**NOTE:** Best Puppy, Best Bred By Exhibitor & Best Veteran Competitions will be held after the Best of Breed Competition / before Stud Dog, Brood Bitch or Brace Classes

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES ..... Multiple Dog Entries**

**STUD DOG CLASS .....** for stud dogs and at least two, but no more than four, of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Judging to be on the merits of the get. Get must be entered in another class in this show. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS .....** same as for the stud dog *except* substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

**NOTE:** Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males may be entered as Stud Dog and spayed females may be entered as Brood Bitch.

**BRACE CLASS** ..... Fee is \$15.00 as a unit

Effective 1/1/05 – **Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs in the Brace must have at least one common owner.**

Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry.

If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is **NOT ENTERED** in a Regular Class at this show, it must be entered for **“BRACE CLASS ONLY”** with the appropriate Individual Entry Fees plus “Brace As A Unit” Fee.

In making entries for “Brace Class Only”, full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class, Brace must be marked as an “Additional Class”. If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Brace as “Brace # 1”, “Brace # 2”, etc.

**NOTE:** As the judges decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

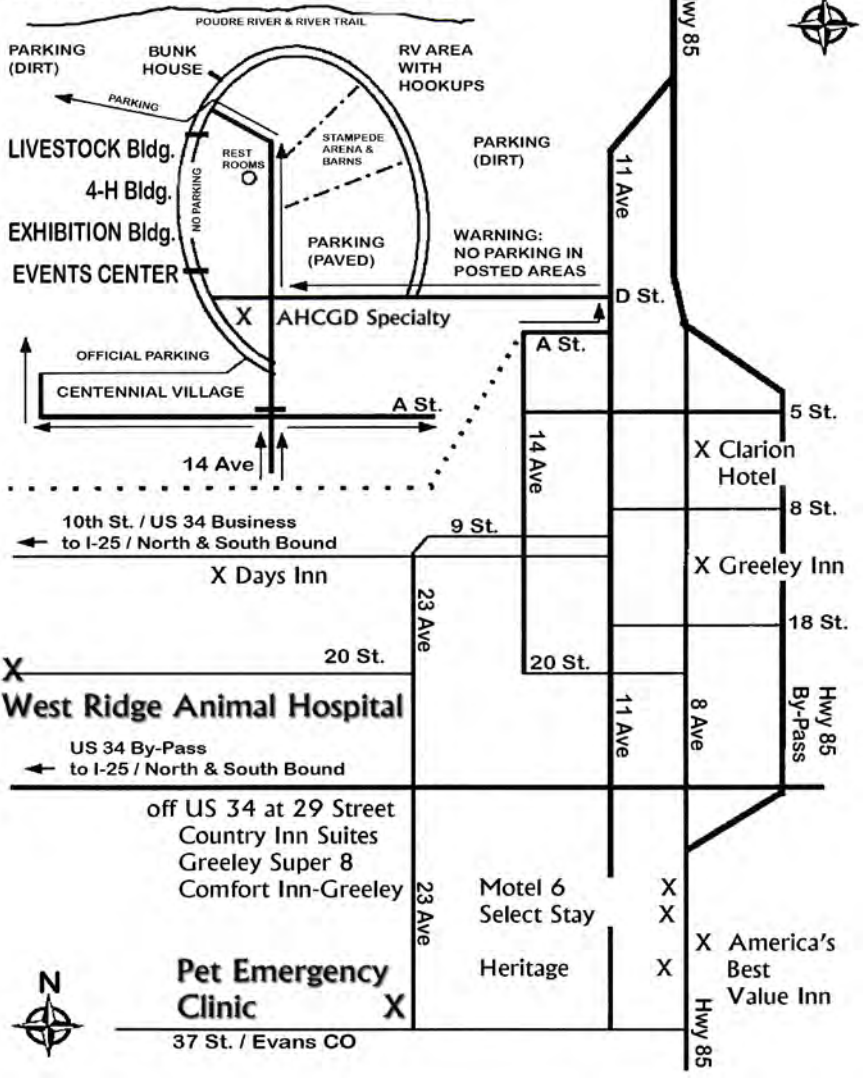

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
