STUD DOG CLASS for stud dogs and at least two, but no more than four, of their get Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Judging to be on the merits of the get. Get must be entered in another class in this show. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules.

BROOD BITCH CLASS same as for the stud dog *except* substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** as Stud Dog and spayed females **may be entered** as Brood Bitch.

BRACE CLASS Fee is \$15.00 as a unit

Effective 1/1/05 – Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs in the Brace must have at least one common owner.

Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry.

If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is **NOT ENTERED** in a Regular Class at this show, it must be entered for "**BRACE CLASS ONLY**" with the appropriate Individual Entry Fees plus "Brace As A Unit" Fee.

In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class, Brace must be marked as an "Additional Class". If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Brace as "Brace # 1", "Brace # 2", etc.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed or obedience classes at the show, or must be entered for JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarians excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the below ownership requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an Official AKC Entry Form. All such requests must be made one-half hour prior to the judging of any Regular Classes at the show.

Each dog must be owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Bitches in season are not eligible. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge, or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by a veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Entries for regular Junior Showmanship Classes shall close at the same time that entries close for this show.


